Tuesday, May 31, 2005 10:30 a.m. The time has come and I'm on my way to Switzerland! Thank you for your prayers. They are an enormous blessing as I make this transition.

Wednesday, June 1, 2005 5 a.m. (Zurich time) As I write this paragraph I'm about 3 hours from Zurich. My flight from Charlotte was delayed over an hour due to mechanical problems and for a time it looked likely that I would miss my connecting flight to Zurich in Washington. However, we finally got airborne and arrived in Washington/Dulles with about 30 minutes to spare. I am scheduled to arrive in Switzerland on June 1st at 8:10 a.m.

Wednesday, June 1, 2005 2 p.m. I'm here! Thankfully my bags also made it which was a bit uncertain with such a short connection time between the two flight. Martin Zimmermann, a classmate and friend of mine from Moody Aviation, lives near Zurich picked me up at the airport after arriving yesterday morning after 6 weeks in California completing his aviation training with MAF (Mission Aviation Fellowship). The primary projects of the day are keeping me awake until normal bedtime and getting my train passes and travel plans to Neuchatel finalized.

Thank you so much for your love and prayers along the way. The flight was very good and it is a huge blessing to have friends waiting on the other end.
